

## Additional Registration Information:

Confirmations will be mailed for registrations received at least seven days prior to the conference; thereafter, registrants will receive their receipt at on-site registration in the lobby of the Eccles Conference Center.

### LTD Transportation Information

The LTD Transit Center, is located at 150 East 500 North. Drivers are instructed to only pick up passengers at approved bus stops, which are located throughout the Valley. Bus stops are easy to find. We recommend that you be at your bus stop at least three minutes early so that you do not miss your bus.

There is no charge to ride the buses. Routes 1 through 9 begin and end their routes at the Transit Center on the hour and half-past each hour. The Cache Valley North and South routes will arrive at the Transit Center every hour and a half at :15 or :45 past the hour. This makes transferring from bus to bus very easy. We have a wonderful new transit center to make your transfer more comfortable. This building has an indoor seated waiting area, information booth, public phones, restrooms, and drinking fountains.

All LTD/CVTD buses are equipped with a bike rack on the front. They are sturdy and easy to use.

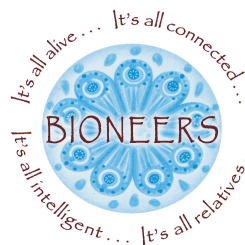
